	Programs in TDLC	Program Details	Contact
1	*New (presented in Shanghai meeting) Disaster Nursing	VC enabled program on nursing in disaster situations, dealing with disaster preparedness, response, and rehabilitation held twice in partnership with Japan Nursing Association and GDLNAP colleagues. Approximately 790 nurses and front-line health providers in Indonesia and Timor Leste joined in the 1st course in February 2009 for the first course, and a total of 328 participants from 8 venues from East and South Asian countries successfully completed the second 2-day intensive learning course in May 2012. Next delivery of the course is planned in <b>early 2013 (March or April)</b> .	Yuka
2	Partogram	In collaboration with WHO, TDLC developed a blended learning course on Partograph which a simple and reliable tool for graphic recording of progress of labour and monitoring the health of the mother and the fetus. This 2-3 weeks course is consisted with F2F session, CDROM self-study and Q&A VC session. In 2010, first blended learning course on partograph course was held and 286 participants joined. 212 participants joined in the second blended learning course. The next delivery is scheduled in <b>May, 2013</b> .	Yuka
3	9th Microfinance Training of Trainers Course (MFTOT9) *jointly organized by ADBI, CDB, and TDLC	9th delivery of the MFTOT course continues to deliver high quality microfinance training in Asia-Pacific and Africa utilizing blended learning approach. The course is a certification course, yielding 893 certified trainers from 55 countries so far (nearly 2,000 undertook the course) co-sponsored by ADBI and CDB. <b>The course registration will start in May and the course implementation date is July-November 2013.</b>	Asako

5	<p>VC Lecture series on "Labour"</p>	<p>In collaboration with ILO, TDLC has been delivering a VC lecture series on labour since 2010. For year 2013, we plan to deliver 4 lectures (out of which, 1st lecture on youth employment delivered in late Nov 2012). 2nd session will be on CSR and labour, which is planned to be delivered in late January. <b>3rd session will be on disaster and labour in late Feb or March, and 4th session will be on decent work in April or May (TBD).</b></p>	<p>Yuka</p>

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
