- Affiliates = DLCs
- DLCs : same standards in terms of physical premises
- Started with 8 DLCs in 2000: Benin, Cote d'ivoire, Ethiopia, Ghana, Mozambique, Senegal, Tanzania, Uganda
- 14 DLCs in 2010 with Angola, Burkina Faso, Kenya, Mali, Madagascar, Mauritania
- Upcoming DLCs: Cameroon, Nigeria, South Africa, Zambia

- Existence of a Regional governance structure named Association of African Distance Learning Centres (AADLC) since May 2003
