## 2nd Delivery of Disaster Nurse Training Course

### Organizer:

TDLC in partnership with the Japan Nursing Association

### Date implemented:

May 7-8, 2012

### VC connecting sites:

Indonesia (2), Nepal (2), Philippines, Sri Lanka, Thailand and Vietnam (2)

### Highlights:

- The majority of participants were nurses with over 5 years or more clinical experience, as well as other public health care practitioners who wished to learn the essential foundations of disaster nursing.
- Approximately 790 nurses and front-line health providers in Indonesia and Timor Leste joined the 1st course delivery in 2009, and a total of 328 participants from 8 venues across EAP and SAR successfully completing this second course delivery in May 2012.



## 8<sup>th</sup> Microfinance Training of Trainers (MFTOT) Course

**Organizers:** ADBI, CDB, and TDLC  
with support from Sri Lanka DLC

**Date implemented:**

December 2011- April 2012

**VC connecting sites:**

Bangladesh, Japan, Mongolia, Nepal, PNG, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Ethiopia, Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda

**Highlights:**

- Nearly 1500 microfinance practitioners and trainers undertook the course within 8 deliveries, among which 893 from 59 countries have received certification as MF trainers.
- "Graduates" continue to support the program by returning as tutors and leaders of localization efforts within their own countries.
- Localization has been undertaken in China, Vietnam, Indonesia, Cambodia, Lao PDR, Thailand, and Mongolia. MFTOT China has been delivered 4 times yielding 595 trainers.



## Blended Learning Program on Science and Policy of Climate Change 2012

### Organizers:

TERI, IGES, and TDLC

### Date implemented:

April – July 2012

### VC connecting sites:

Bangladesh, China, India, Indonesia, Japan, Madagascar, Sri Lanka, Uganda, Vietnam (Hanoi), Vietnam (Ho Chi Minh)

### Highlights:

- The 4-month intensive program aims to raise awareness and enhance understanding of the implications of climate change.
- 121 from 25 countries undertook the 2nd delivery of the course, which amounts to 277 from 34 countries in 2 deliveries (2011 & 2012)



# Introduction to Islamic Finance

## Organizers:

AADLC and TDLC  
with experts from WB, JBIC and IsDB

## Date implemented:

May 14 – June 7, 2012

## VC connecting sites:

French: Senegal, Mauritania, Côte d'Ivoire, Benin, Madagascar, Mali and Burkina Faso  
English: Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Japan, and China-Shanghai

## Highlights:

- The program with four VC sessions consisting of a 2.5 hours interactive lecture and Q&A was joined by 243 policymakers and practitioners in financial sector from 10 African countries.
- A total of 188 participants had attended at least three sessions (77.4% of registered participants) and were eligible to receive completion certificates.
